

Instructions Manual

OVERVIEW

This template has been specifically designed to be easily customized with all content driven by XML which means you can update content without editing the FLA. This manual will guide you through the process of customizing this template with your own content. For those who wish to 'tweak' the flash, all FLA files are included and all code has been well commented.

GETTING STARTED

TEMPLATE LOGO AND FOOTER SETTINGS

To adjust template setting you need to edit **index.xml** using a simple text editing program such as Notepad on PC or TextEdit on MAC. NB It's not recommended to use Dreamweaver to edit XML as it can cause problems.

Between the settings tags you will see a tag for **logo**. Here you can set the path to the image for the logo and adjust it's X and Y position. The current logo is saved in the "content" folder. In the **footer** tag you can set the footer text which appears at the bottom left of the template. This text is HTML formatted so you can change colour to text and add hyperlinks.

Commented in blue below is a description of each of the menu settings that you can set:

To add a standard module, such as Slideshow, News etc see the following options in the entry:

USING TOLOAD TO CREATE MULTIPLE INSTANCES OF A MODULE

With the toLoad option you can use multiple instances of the same module in the template. All you need to do is create a new folder with content and edit content.xml. Then link it in index.xml

NB DEEPLINKING

When you create new content pages make sure you always give a **unique name** for the SWFAddressURL, ie no other page must have that name. Otherwise the menu navigation won't function correctly. Also try not to use spaces in the name, use _ or - to separate words.

Below is XML the entry for the background.

To set a background per section use **bgID** attribute in content page entries 0=first bg, 1=second bg, 2=third bg etc. See **Image** attribute to set path to load the background image.

Below is XML the entry for the music

See **DefaultVolume** attribute to set default music volume. See **Thumb** attribute to set path to load the album art. See **Artist** attribute to set name of artist. See **Title** attribute to set name of title of track. See **Path** attribute to set path to load the MP3.

See **Target** attribute to set same window or new window for the links, either "_blank" or "_self". See **Title** attribute to set name of link appearing in hover caption. See **Link** attribute to set URL path for each link.

SLIDESHOW MODULE

To add content, first add your images to the "slideshow" folder. Then you need to edit **content.xml** in the slideshow folder to set the image paths, copy text and other settings. Here is the XML structure:

XML SETTINGS

See above in blue text is an explanation of the various settings to customise this component via XML. If you change the size of your thumbnail images, set attributes **ThumbWidth** and **ThumbHeight**. If you change the size of your large images, set attributes **ImageWidth** and **ImageHeight**.

EDITING XML CONTENT

To set the title of each entry, see **Name** attribute between the <item> tags. See **Thumb** and **Large** attributes to set the path to the images. To set the delay between each image in slideshow mode, see **Delay** attribute (millisecond based). To add an external link on the large image, see attribute **Link** or leave blank for no link. In the <copy> tags you can set your copy which in the info panel on large image rollover. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

For the title text you can have one or multiple titles by adding or removing title entries. **X** and **Y** attributes are for the title positioning. **Align** attributes are for alignment, either set to "left", "centre" or "right". **Alpha** attribute is for title background transparency. **Colour** attribute is for the title background colour. You can set the text colour using HTML tag between the CDATA tags.

EDITING THE FLA

If you want to change code or elements in the FLA open **slideshow fla** Inside movieclip "content_mc" you will see the code in the Actions layer. See comments in the code for further help.

NEWS / TEAM MODULE

To add content, first add your images to the news folder. Then you need to edit **content.xml** in the news OR team folder to set the image paths, copy text and other settings. Here is the XML structure:

Inside movieclip "window_mc" you will see code in the Actions layer for the article window. See comments in the code for further help.

To add content, first add your images to the content folder. Then you need to edit **content.xml** in the content folder to set the image paths, copy text and other settings. Here is the XML structure:

In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

EDITING THE FLA

If you want to change code or elements in the FLA open **content fla** Inside movieclip "content_mc" you will see the code in the Actions layer for the news items.

To add content, first add your images to the media_gallery folder. Then you need to edit **content.xml** in the media_gallery folder to set the image paths, copy text and other settings. Here is the XML structure:

See above in blue text is an explanation of the various settings to customise this component via XML. If you change the size of your thumbnail images, set attributes **ThumbWidth** and **ThumbHeight**.

ADDING IMAGES (JPG, PNG, GIF)

To see **Title** attribute to set name of each entry. See **Thumb** and **Content** attributes to set the thumb and large images. To add an external link on the thumbnail and by-pass the content page, see attribute **LinkThumb** OR leave blank to link to the article page. In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

ADDING AUDIO (MP3, WAV)

To see **Artist** attribute to set title of the track. See **Title** attribute to set title of track. See **Thumb** attribute to set the path to thumb. To add an external link on the thumbnail and by-pass the content page, see attribute **LinkThumb** OR leave blank to link to the article page. See **AlbumArt** attribute to set the path to album art. See **Content** attribute to set the path to load the music file. In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

ADDING AUDIO (FLV, F4V, MP4, MOV)

See **Title** attribute to set title of the video. See **Thumb** attribute to set the path to thumb. To add an external link on the thumbnail and by-pass the content page, see attribute **LinkThumb** OR leave blank to link to the article page. See **Content** attribute to set the path to load the video file. See **Width** and **Height** attributes to set the default size of the video. In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

ADDING FLASH (SWF)

See **Title** attribute to set title of the Flash file. See **Thumb** attribute to set the path to thumb. To add an external link on the thumbnail and by-pass the content page, see attribute **LinkThumb** OR leave blank to link to the article page. See **Content** attribute to set the path to load the flash file. See **Width** and **Height** attributes to set the size of the flash file. In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags.

EDITING THE FLA

If you want to change code or elements in the FLA open **media_gallery fla** Inside movieclip "content_mc" you will see the code in the Actions layer for the news items.

CONTACT MODULE

To add content, first add your map image the to "contact" folder. Then you need to edit **content.xml** to set the map image path, copy text and other settings. Here is the XML structure:

To set the form title, see attribute **FormName** To set the map title, see attribute **MapName** To set the hyperlink colour, see attribute **LinkColour** To set the hyperlink hover colour, see attribute **HoverColour**

EDITING XML CONTENT

In the copy tags you can set your copy which appears above the form and map. This copy is HTML formatted so you can set text colour, size and decoration and add hyperlinks using standard HTML tags. In the map tag you can set the path to the map image, see attribute **Image** In the email tag you can set the email address the form submits to, see attribute **SendTo**

EDITING THE FLA

If you want to change code or elements in the FLA open **contact fla** Inside movieclip "content_mc" you will see code in the Actions layer for the form. Inside movieclip "map_mc" you will see code in the Actions layer for the map. There are some settings you can change in the initial settings. See comments in the code for further help.

TROUBLESHOOTING: PHP FORM DOES NOT SEND MESSAGE TO MY EMAIL

This might be because your server does not support PHP scripts or it has not been enabled or configured correctly. To check if your server supports PHP scripts, go to the contact folder in the supplied files upload "phpinfo.php" to your server. If PHP is enabled and working correctly you should see your server's PHP information when you access "phpinfo.php" on your server. If you get an error you'll need to contact your hosting provider to enable PHP before your flash PHP contact form will work.

Also double check that your email address is correct in your XML.

FLASH DOES NOT DISPLAY CONTENT AFTER EDITING THE XML

Most likely there is an error in your XML file after editing. To debug errors, an easy way is to open the XML in a browser window. If there is an error it will tell you. Fix the error in the XML, save and reopen the XML in the browser window again to see if there are any more errors. Once all the errors have been fixed you should see the XML tree in the browser window. When you save the XML always choose 'save as' and set the encoding type to UTF -8 before saving the XML.

If you SWF uses "TL" alignment, make sure to set TopLeft="true" otherwise set it to false.

INTERNAL LINKS

To add an internal link on a button from your SWF to navigate to a page in your template, call the following function

_global.internalLink("4"); (This will go to the 5th page in the menu)

EXTERNAL LINKS

To add an external link in the main menu, open index.xml and the XML entry will be as follows:

NB Make sure SWFAddressURL="" EMPTY" otherwise it will cause issues.

TOGGELING PLAYLIST MUSIC AUDIO ON/OFF

If you are adding content which has music you can mute the music volume by calling the following global command:

HYPERLINK INTERNAL LINKS

Below is an example of how to insert a hyperlink in the XML text to link to an internal content page which does not use the toLoad variable in the XML text.

To add an internal link to a sub menu section, use the following:

You can see an example of internal links in XML text by viewing the slideshow **content.xml** file.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PHP FORM DOES NOT SEND MESSAGE TO MY EMAIL

This might be because your server does not support PHP scripts or it has not been enabled or configured correctly. To check if your server supports PHP scripts, go to the contact folder in the supplied files upload "phpinfo.php" to your server. If PHP is enabled and working correctly you should see your server's PHP information when you access "phpinfo.php" on your server. If you get an error you'll need to contact your hosting provider to enable PHP before your flash PHP contact form will work.

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GENERAL FILE FAQ

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
